To our valued customers:

Vaccination has become an extremely important layer of protection in how we can keep everyone safe, shown in clinical research to be consistently 95 percent or greater in reducing severe illness and death, as reported widely in the media.

Government and many organizations like ours recognize these facts and as such require vaccination in the workplace. Increasingly, more event spaces, travel locations, and public venues are mandating full vaccination for entry. These policies have come about based on research and by advocacy by medical voices around the globe and here in Canada.

By the very nature of our business, we provide life saving and life sustaining products to the healthcare market. In this pandemic, we have been called upon to play a key role in COVID-19 vaccine distribution for provincial ministries of health. Since the beginning of the pandemic, we have implemented all public health directives to protect both our people and the highest service standards our clients expect from Accuristix and Nova Pack.

This is why, effective October 1, 2021, we will implement a new policy that requires ALL individuals who work at Accuristix and Nova Pack to be either fully vaccinated or, in the absence of full vaccination, required to submit to a COVID test that indicates a negative result every 72 hours while actively at work. Test kits and appropriate testing areas will be made available at all facilities.

As much as our policy aligns to our environment, it also results from client requests. For example, both customers and consignees are beginning to mandate that drivers be fully vaccinated for pick ups and deliveries, and we anticipate similar, growing requests.

With this policy, we are working to ensure the continued safety and protection of our people, our services, and of those to whom we deliver.
